I achieved my goals, so I am very happy to be here.

We shared the task among ourselves for the gift.

So when I gave this as a gift, I wanted it to be relevant. The heart expresses love, goodness, beauty.

Birds represent freedom, peace and goodness. That's why I thought of such a gift.

It's nice to have two religions unite with us in this room. Different languages, religions, cultures came together, which humanity needs.

3-

I did not think of my dream or my dream that I wanted to see today or yesterday. I have been chasing this dream and this dream for thirty years. My dream was to build a new world full of love, to create islands of peace where people live in peace, a world that accepts everyone as they are, a world where I can have a heart where I can sit with each other in my heart.

That's why I'm here. I'm in the right place and I'm happy that I made the right decision. I didn't want to miss this opportunity. I've worked for years

as a volunteer in aid organizations. After I came to Germany, I worked as a volunteer in Tafel. And I try to help people with physical and mental disabilities.

When I was about 12 years old, I was not thinking of reading. One of my teachers set a good example for me. I decided to study. He taught me what I have just expressed. For 30 years I have lived with the dream and hope of this and I will continue to do so. I will explain why I wrote this at the end of my article.

Why did I tell this: The story of Prophet Yusuf, as told in the Quran, was an example for Prophet Muhammad. That's why I think we should tell the story of Prophet Yusuf as an example.

One of the most beautiful things I gained in this program was this:

Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) is a piece of meat in a human being. If it is good, the human being is good. If that piece of meat is bad, the human being will be bad. That piece of meat is the heart.
